(the Papal Legate) are to compel them with the church's censure and other appropriate

measures. From this order there is no appeal."

leant its papal authority to the long standing persecution of

Jews.Particular during the Christian Holy Week of Passion, Christians frequently rioted against the Jews or refused to sell them food in the hope of starving them. At the beginning of the 13th Century POPE INNOCENT lll required Jews to wear distinctive clothing. (Deje Vou Hitler).

By 1391 the Archdeacon of Seville launched a "holy war against the Jews".By 1492 the inquisition of Spain had become so virulent in its persecution of Jews that it demanded either their conversion to Christianity or their expulsion.Not surprisingly, Islamic countries offered far safer sanctuaries to escaping Jews than Christian lands...
